Modern Slavery is a crime and a violation of fundamental human rights. It takes various forms, such as slavery, servitude, forced and compulsory labour and human trafficking, all of which have in common the deprivation of a person's liberty by another to exploit them for personal or commercial gain.

Fairtrade Vending Ltd is committed to improving our practices to combat slavery and human trafficking.

Fairtrade Vending is fully aware of the responsibilities it bears towards employees and the local community and as such, we have a strict set of values that we use as guidance regarding our activities. We therefore would expect that all suppliers to the company adhere to the same principles.

As part of our commitment Fairtrade Vending have reviewed our supply chains and have introduced a 'Supplier Code of Conduct' and have requested all existing and new suppliers to confirm that they are compliant with the Act.
